We have arranged for an end of year visit for all Years 5 and 6 pupils to the Heights of Abraham on **Friday 19th July 2024**.

The Heights of Abraham is a 60-acre Georgian hilltop estate, first opened in 1787. Located on the edge of the Peak District in Matlock Bath and accessed by an exciting flight in a cable car, with two underground cavern tours, exhibitions, adventure play and stunning views, the Heights is a fun-filled educational day out! We shall be leaving school promptly at 9.00am and returning at approximately 3:00pm.

The total cost for the visit is £25.00 per child, this includes entrance and transport costs.

The visit is open to all pupils in Years 5 and 6, but the school reserves the right to refuse participation to any pupil whose behaviour in school is judged unacceptable.

To safeguard your child's place on this visit, your **non-refundable payment** must be received **no later than Friday 7th June**.

Please note that if your child does not wish to partake in this visit, they will be expected to attend school as per normal.

Pupils will be in small-supervised groups with a member of staff and will require a packed lunch and snack for the day; however nuts, glass/metal bottles and fizzy drinks are not permitted. If your child receives free school meals and would like a school packed lunch provided by the school, please ask your child to inform the school kitchen, by **Monday 8th July 2024**.
