PSHCE: Year 7 Stereotyping

Next term, as part of our Key Stage 3 PSHCE studies we will be starting a unit of work on Stereotyping.

Our studies follow the National Curriculum and cover the human reproductive cycle including: changes to your body during puberty; sexuality and stereotypical, relationships and what is sexual intercourse.

We will be viewing and discussing a number of programs aimed at your child's age group on these issues, in addition to undergoing written work for your child to demonstrate an understanding of the subjects. These lessons also support Science lessons, which may have been previously delivered on Stereotyping, however within PSHCE we explore the moral sides of the subject and understanding the rights and wrongs as well as individual's beliefs.
