Expectations for Conduct on School Premises

I am writing to remind all parents and carers of the importance of maintaining a safe, respectful and calm environment on the school premises at all times.

At Ryecroft CE Middle School, we operate a **zero-tolerance** approach to any form of aggressive, abusive, or inappropriate behaviour on our site. This applies to all members of the school community, including visitors and parents.

Unacceptable behaviour includes, but is not limited to:

- Shouting at or using aggressive language towards staff
- Intimidating or confrontational behaviour
- Swearing or use of offensive language
- Physical aggression or fighting
- Threatening language or actions

Such behaviour will not be tolerated and may result in an immediate ban from the school premises, with further steps taken as necessary to protect staff and pupils.

We understand that there may be occasions when parents feel upset or frustrated, but it is essential that concerns are raised in a calm and respectful manner. Staff will always aim to listen and support, but they must be treated with courtesy at all times.
