We are excited to share an update on the preparations for your child's iPad to be used at home.

Right now, our team is working hard to make sure that all the filtering and monitoring systems are set up and running smoothly. This is a really important step, as it means we can be confident that every device will be safe and secure when your child takes it home.

Alongside this, pupils have been learning about online safety and how to use their iPad responsibly. These conversations are helping them to build the awareness and skills they'll need to make the most of their device both in and out of school.

Next week, you will receive an Acceptable Use Policy and Parental Agreement. These need to be read, signed, and returned before an iPad can be sent home.

Once everything is in place and the agreements have been collected, we will be ready to start sending iPads home with pupils, a big step forward in this exciting project!
