On **Thursday 18th December 2025**, we have arranged an exciting visit for all pupils to the **New Vic Theatre in Stoke-on-Trent** to watch a brand-new adaptation of Hans Christian Andersen's classic fairytale, *The Little Mermaid*.

This spectacular production combines **contemporary circus performance**, **enchanting storytelling**, **live music and magical moments of adventure**. Set in a vibrant coral reef, it tells the story of a young mermaid with a heart full of dreams who longs to explore the world above the sea. When she saves a human boy in danger, she sets out on an extraordinary journey of hope, love and self-discovery.
