Year 7 Science: Reproduction and Growth

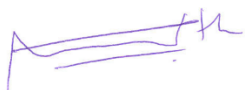
As part of their Key Stage 3 Science studies, your child will shortly be starting a unit of work on reproduction and growth.

Our studies follow the National Curriculum and cover the human reproductive cycle including conception; fertilisation and foetal development; genetics; growth; development; adolescence; behaviour and how health can be affected by diet; drugs and disease. We will be considering how knowledge and understanding of science informs personal and collective decisions, including those on sexual health.

In addition, we will arrange sessions for the girls and separately with the boys to discuss the physical and emotional changes that are associated with adolescence. We will also be viewing and discussing a number of programmes aimed at your child's age group on these issues.
