This exhibition complements the current non-statutory guidelines for Religious Education in the UK and provides an engaging way for pupils to explore the story of Christianity and its relevance today.

The exhibition makes use of interactive tablets, graphic panels, quizzes, films, songs and even a discussion café. In just over an hour, children are able to learn in a lively and memorable way. It is particularly suited to Upper Key Stage 2 and links with elements of the Staffordshire Agreed Syllabus.

- **Year 6:** Morning session
- **Year 5:** Afternoon session
- **Travel:** Pupils will travel by coach
- **Cost:** There will be no cost to parents as the exhibition is free, thanks to the generous sponsorship of local churches and the Christian charity, Counties.
