Dear Parents/Carers

We are delighted to inform you that we have arranged an end-of-year visit for all pupils to attend **Alton Towers Theme Park on Thursday 16th July 2026**.

Alton Towers has extensive experience in hosting school visits, and the safety of our pupils is always our highest priority. Please be assured that all appropriate procedures will be in place throughout the day.

- **Timings:** The visit will depart promptly from school at **9:00am** and return at approximately **3:00pm**. Pupils must attend school at the normal time for morning registration and travel with the school party.
- **Extended Stay Option:** We understand that some parents may wish for their child to remain at Alton Towers beyond the school day. While this can be accommodated, please note that the school cannot take responsibility for pupils who stay behind. Parents must make their own arrangements for collection. (The Park closes at 6:00pm).
- **Collection Changes:** Once you have submitted your request regarding whether your child will return to school with staff or stay at the theme park for later collection, this option **cannot be changed**.
- **Supervision:** Pupils will be unsupervised during the visit, but staff will be available in a designated areas should they need assistance. If you wish your child to be in supervised group, please state this option on the online consent form via the link below.

Cost: No action required until after Sunday 15th March 2026. A message will be sent out when payment is live Arbor.

- Full visit (ticket and transport): **£28.00 per child**
- Transport only (if your child has their own valid ticket/pass): **£5.00 (one-way or return)**

Action required: At this stage, we need to confirm how many tickets to provisionally order. If your child already has their own valid ticket, or pass they must bring it with them on the day, as the school will be unable to provide tickets at the venue.
