Fidget Toys


We wanted to share a reminder regarding the use of fidget toys in school. Recently, a number of pupils have been bringing toys from home to use in class. While we recognise that, for some children, a carefully chosen fidget can support focus and self-regulation, toys brought from home can become a distraction both for the child using them and for others.

To help maintain a calm and purposeful learning environment, we kindly ask that children do not bring any fidget toys or similar items into school.

If we feel that a pupil would genuinely benefit from a fidget or sensory tool to support their learning, the school will assess this and provide an appropriate resource. This ensures that any fidget used in class is suitable, purposeful, and in line with our teaching and learning expectations.
