I am writing to share a concern regarding a recent increase in damage and graffiti to our school property and environment. This has been disappointing and saddening to see, as it does not reflect the respect and pride we would hope all of our pupils demonstrate towards our school.

We are proud of our beautiful environment, and it is important that everyone in our school community helps to take care of it. We have spoken with all children about the importance of respecting school property and doing the right thing if they witness someone intentionally causing damage. This includes reporting concerns to a member of staff so that issues can be addressed promptly.

We kindly ask that you reinforce this message at home by encouraging your child to take pride in their surroundings and to act responsibly at all times.

As part of our discussions with the children, we have reinforced these expectations. I would also like to clarify that no child has been, nor will be, prevented from accessing the toilet. We are however monitoring movement around the school more closely to support the safety and wellbeing of all pupils, as well as to protect our environment, and this has been made clear to children.

Thank you for your continued support in helping us maintain a safe, respectful, and welcoming school for everyone.
